Why Should a Student Participate in Dual Enrollment @ the GRCCA?

Articulation: All core academic college courses have guaranteed transferability between the University System of Georgia & Technical College System of Georgia Institutions in Georgia.

Transportation: PCHS provides bus transportation to and from the GRCCA daily.

Calendar: Only high school students, no adult students, so college are able to work with us to make sure students get all of their high school breaks: Fall Break, Thanksgiving, Christmas Break, Winter Break, Spring Break, and teacher work day breaks. Instructors come to our building and follow our calendar.

New for 2023-2024 - Academic Cohorts. Students will follow a sequence of USG/TCSG core academic courses using the 24-30 hours of dual enrollment paid by the state in order to take full advantage of the free college credits the state has to offer.
