Scholarship Application 2023-2024

The Concerned Citizens for Pike County Scholarship Fund, supported by the Pike County Branch NAACP Unit 5228, was established for the purpose of providing financial assistance to students who meet the following criteria:

- 1. The applicant must be a high school senior planning to enroll in an accredited institution of higher education for the purpose of obtaining a certificate, associate's degree, bachelor's degree, the equivalent, or more.
- 2. The applicant must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 on a 4-point grading scale and a minimum SAT score of 800, or the equivalent of at least 17 on the ACT.
- 3. The applicant must be planning to enroll in a full-time course of study, 12-15 semester hours or the equivalent.
- 4. The applicant should have a **current official transcript(sealed and signed by Registrar)** sent to: **Concerned Citizens for Pike County, PO Box 175, Zebulon, GA 30295** by **March 1** of the current year.
- 5. The applicant must **complete** and **mail** the scholarship application and two (2) letters of recommendation to: **Concerned Citizens for Pike County by** <u>March 1</u> of the current year. A letter of recommendation from each of the following must be included:
 - a. A teacher
 - b. A non-related person of your choosing
- 6. The applicant must attend Pike County High School or parent(s) must be a member of Concerned Citizens for Pike County to be eligible for Concerned Citizens for Pike County Scholarship.

***<u>Applications, transcripts, and letters of recommendation postmarked</u> <u>after March 1</u> <u>will NOT be considered</u>.

3. Scholarship Application (Must be completed for high school applicants)
4. Autobiographical Sketch (Must be typed for high school applicants)
5. Two letters of recommendation from a teacher, a non-related person of your choice, a pastor mentor, or another person of your choice (Required for high school applicants)
