



The purpose of the Pike County Arts Council scholarship is to assist outstanding students who plan to pursue a career focusing: on media, design, culinary, fashion, visual or performing arts and who exhibit leadership skills in the community. The \$ 1 000 scholarship will be applied to the spring semester 2025.

To be eligible, applicant must:

1. Be a Pike County resident.
2. Be a graduating high school senior.
3. During the 2024-2025 academic year, enroll in any accredited college/university with an art program.
4. Pursue an undergraduate degree
5. Have a minimum 3 .0 GP A.
6. Be engaged in high school leadership activities.

Supporting documents required:

1. Essay outlining your future plans as they relate to art and how you think you can impact the future of the art (media, design, culinary, fashion, visual or performing arts) industry. The essay should be at least one page, but no more than two pages, double spaced, Times New Roman or Arial; 12 point font.
2. Copy of transcript.
3. Two letters of reference from teachers and/or applicable school representatives (counselors, principals, club advisors, etc.).
4. Photo of the applicant.
5. Due to high school consolors' office March 27, 2024.
